### **FLOOD INFORMATION LINE SHUTS DOWN AS CALLS DECLINE**

VICTORIA – As requests for information on flooding have declined, the Province's flood information line will close down Friday, June 15 at 8 p.m. after more than three weeks of operation.

The Province, in partnership with the Canadian Red Cross, operated the toll-free line to provide up-to-date daily information on the spring flood situation throughout British Columbia. TELUS donated the centre's technology to the Red Cross.

Approximately 1,900 calls were handled by Red Cross volunteers since the line began operation on May 22.
